

**TOWN OF CORTLANDVILLE
LOCAL LAW OF THE YEAR 2017**

CHANGE OF OFFICE OF SUPERINTENDENT OF HIGHWAYS FROM ELECTED TO APPOINTIVE

A Local Law providing for the abolition of the elective office of Town Highway Superintendent and creation of the appointive office of Town Highway Superintendent of the Town of Cortlandville

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Cortlandville as follows:

Section 1.

Pursuant to Municipal Home Rule Law §10, the Town of Cortlandville hereby abolishes the Elective Office of the Town Highway Superintendent; the abolition of said office to take effect on December 31, 2019.

Section 2.

The appointive office of Town Highway Superintendent of the Town of Cortlandville is hereby created as of January 1, 2020.

Section 3.

At the biennial Town election succeeding the effective date of this local law, no Town Highway Superintendent shall be elected, and upon the expiration of the term of the Town Highway Superintendent for whom no successor shall be elected, the Town Board shall appoint a Town Highway Superintendent who shall hold office for a term of two years, commencing with the first day of January 2020.

Section 4.

If a Town Highway Superintendent cannot or does not complete the appointed term, the Town Board will appoint a person to fill the remainder of the Town Highway Superintendent's term.

Section 5.

This Local Law is subject to mandatory referendum according to the provisions of Section 23 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

Section 6.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State and after approval of a majority of the electors voting thereon in accordance with the requirements of Section 23 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
