Attach bond in the amount \$1,000,000.00 dollars each occurrence, property damage \$75,000.00 dollars, Medical (Any one person) \$5,000.00 dollars, Personal & Adv Injury \$1,000,000.00 dollars, and General Aggregate \$2,000,000.00 dollars; or an indemnity insurance policy with liability coverage and indemnity protection naming the Town of Cortlandville or a person or persons to property, by reason of the display so permitted and arising from any acts of the permittee, its agents, employees, contractors or subcontractors

which shall run to the Town of Cortlandville and shall be for the use and benefit of any person(s) or any owner(s) of any property so injured or damaged.

- 25. NOTE: ALL PERMIT RECIPIENTS SHALL BE REQUIRED TO GIVE WRITTEN NOTICE TO ALL PROPERTY OWNERS WITHIN 500 FEET OF THE DISPLAY LOCATION UPON THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT HEREUNDER.
- 26. NOTE: NO PERMIT GRANTED AND ISSUED SHALL BE TRANSFERABLE.
- 27. APPLICANT AGREES TO HOLD THE TOWN OF CORTLANDVILLE, TOWN BOARD, TOWN CLERK, CORTLANDVILLE FIRE DISTRICT, THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS AND ITS OFFICERS, THE VILLAGE OF HOMER, THE HOMER FIRE DEPARTMENT AND ITS OFFICERS, AND THE CORTLAND COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT, HARMLESS AND FREE FROM ANY AND ALL DAMAGES AND CLAIMS ARISING UNDER OR BY VIRTUE OF SAID PERMIT, IF GRANTED.
