Thorpe Municipal Building, 3577 Terrace Road, in the Town of Cortlandville, New York, to consider the following application pursuant to the 1986 Zoning Law:

1. In the matter of the application of 879 Route 13, LLC, for property located at 877 NYS Route 13, Tax Map No. 95.16-02-73.000, for a variance in the terms and conditions of Article XVIII, Section 178-111 (B), 112, Table 1, and 113, Table 2, for a free-standing sign closer to property line than allowed, for a greater number of building-mounted signs and building-mounted signs to be illuminated.

PUBLIC HEARING

879 Route 13, LLC, Applicant/Reputed Owner - 877 NYS Route 13 - TM #95.16-02-73.000 - Signage

Chairman Plew recognized Mr. Swedrock, PE, of BME Associates, representing the applicant who was requesting variances for (1) a free-standing sign closer to the property line than allowed, (2) a greater number of building-mounted signs than allowed, and (3) the illumination of building-mounted signs on this former site of McDonald's (applicant's Parcel B), all as shown on the photos accompanying the application.

Mr. Swedrock explained that the existing building will be demolished, and there will be two tenants in a proposed new building. A new 8-foot high monument sign was also shown to those present; this sign would be closer to the property line than allowed. The three building-mounted signs depicted are to be illuminated.

With no one from the public present to be heard, Chairman Plew closed the Public Hearing at 7:10 p.m.
